

BUTLER HANDLE INSTRUCTIONS

The Butler Handle is designed to fit on the 30 ounce Yeti, or 30 ounce Ozark Trail metal mug or (tumbler). The handle is machined Acetal and the holding bands are steel banding material. The combination of these two materials makes for a very strong handle and one that can be used with your Butler Mug Holding System.

The handle typically comes assembled. So, to place it on your metal mug, you will need to loosen the screws just a small amount. The metal bands will spring open if the nut is taken completely off. This will probably end up with the nut and washer flying across the room. If this happens you will need to compress the band back on the bolt and add the washer and nut, if you can find them. So, try not to take the nut all the way off. It just needs a little looseness.

When correctly placed on the mug, the upper, larger band, lower edge will be about half way between the top of the mug and the point where the mug begins to curve inward. At this point, tighten the bolts/nuts securely. If you need to move the handle upward some, that's ok too. It's important to note that although your 20 ounce Butler Ring will hold the mug securely, when the mug is pressed into the ring, the upper band of the handle serves to prevent the mug from sliding too far down into the ring.
